Founded as a spin-off of Dresden University of Technology in 2003, Signalion GmbH specialised in the development of testers for wireless communications infrastructure, such as for LTE network equipment. In 2012 the company was acquired by National Instruments.

Founded in 2005 as a spin-off of the Freiberg University of Mining and Technology, Freiberg Instruments offers customers worldwide innovative measuring technology. Three main product lines have been developed: for the semiconductor industry (MDP), geology and archaeology (lexsyg), and for the life science, biomedical and chemical industry (ESR).

SPREADSHIRT

The e-commerce platform, which was founded in 2002 in Leipzig, enables individuals, companies and organisations to create, sell and buy ideas on over 150 different products. Spreadshirt is active in 19 markets and 12 languages, operates five production sites worldwide and achieved a turnover of 72 million euro in 2014.
